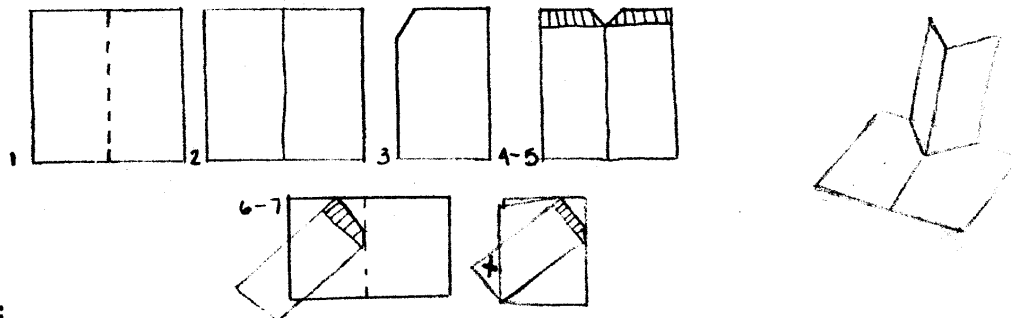


Creating Animated Illustrations

Step-by-Step Instructions for Creating Animated Illustrations

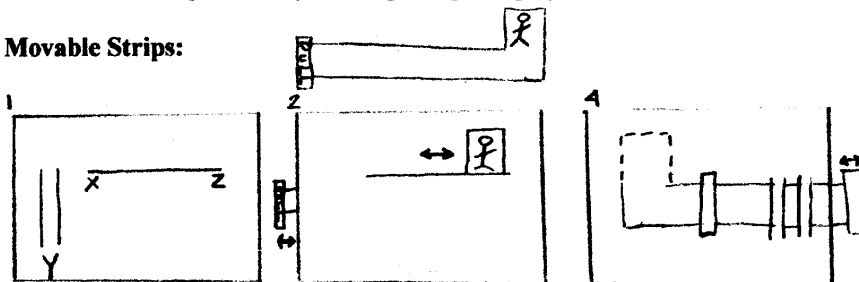
Basic Form:



Steps:

1. Take two sheets of paper. Fold the first piece in half vertically.
2. Take the second piece of paper cut it in half.
3. Fold the cut piece of paper in half.
4. Fold over one end of the folded paper over to create a 1" flap.
5. Cut a diagonal miter in the center of the fold and crease the mitered flaps.
6. Align the mitered corner with the center spine of the first folded page.
7. Glue down the bottom flap to the right hand side of the page.
8. Place glue on the top flap and drop the left side of the page onto the top flap.
9. Leave the page closed and cut off excess.
10. Wait for glue to dry then open up the page and illustrate.

Movable Strips:

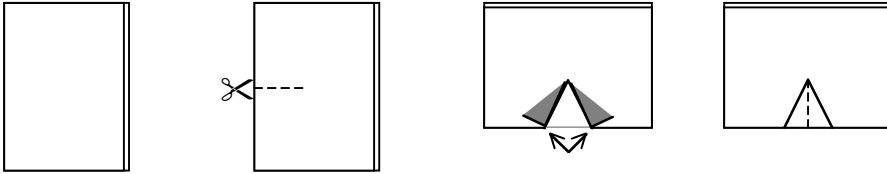


Steps:

1. Cut slots "Y" and X - Z in the page. Thread the movable strip through the "Y" slots to move through slot X - Z
2. Cut the movable strip the distance from the left edge of the page to the end of Slot X - Z.
3. Cut and past a tab on the end of the movable strip that says "PULL".
4. Place a support over the movable strip between Slot X - Z. This will prevent the moveable strip from dropping down.

Moving Mouth

1. Fold paper in half and cut approximately 2" perpendicular to the fold.
2. FIRMLY fold the inner edges of the cut up and out to create two triangular flaps.
3. Push the two flaps back down so the page lies flat.

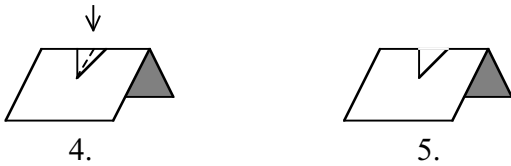

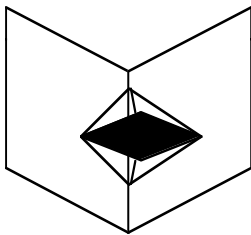
4. Hold the paper up along the center fold so it hangs in a "tent" shape.
5. Have a partner push the two triangular folds downwards through the cut opening and crimp the edges.



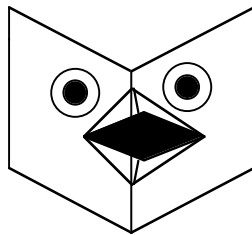

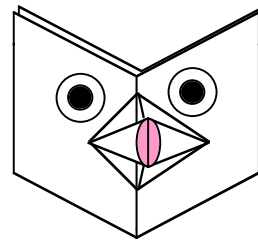
6. Flip the paper over so the "beak" or "mouth" is pointing at you.
7. Draw your illustration around the mouth.
8. If you desire, you can place a second piece of paper behind the opening as a foundation and draw in a tongue and teeth.

Moveable Strip Cutout Windows

1. Cut a square window in the center of the page towards the top of the page.
2. Cut a notched movable strip allowing space for your two illustrations to correspond with the opening cut in the page.
3. Cut "A" and "B" support strips to fasten over the movable strip.
4. Lay the strip on the reverse side of the page and fasten supports "A" and "B" Align the illustration behind the opening.
5. Draw an arrow on the bottom of the movable strip to indicate which way the strip needs to be moved to animate your illustration.
6. This will enable you to position the illustration to be opened.
7. Pull the movable strip downwards to change the illustration.
