

YOUR TOUR OF THE HUDSON!

You will be using a trifold form to create a travel brochure of points you think are of interest along the Hudson River Valley. Use the map of the Hudson River Valley Region which you can find at www.Maps.com to select sites to include in your brochure. Then do an Internet search to gain information and pictures to put into your brochure. (Be sure to label all pictures and information with the web-site you took them from!)

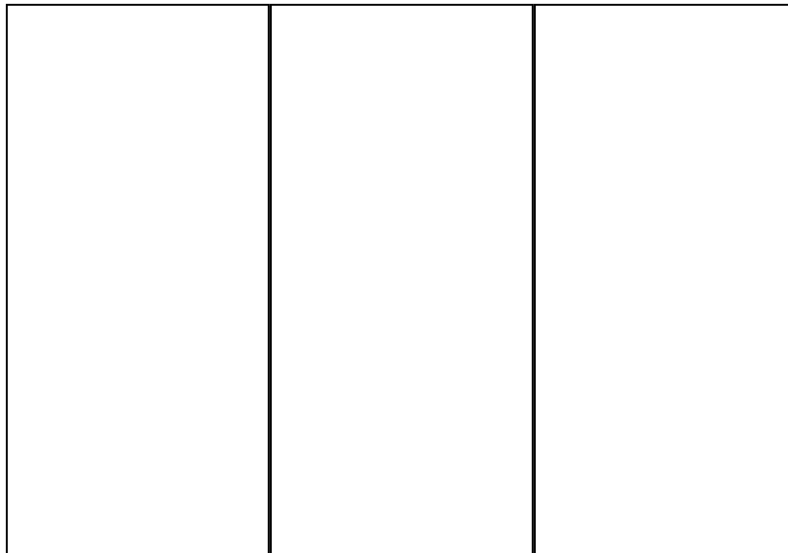
A trifold brochure looks like the diagram shown below.

Step 1

Fold over to the left side on top of the sheet you are working on. This will create a flap which will be inside your finished product.

Step 2

Fold over on the top of the other sections to form the front of your travel brochure.



Remember, you have 6 columns of information space in this brochure. There is room for information on both sides of the sheet of paper.

Lay your information and pictures out in the order you are planning to put them before actually pasting them into the brochure.

Try to put some kind of picture on both the outside and the inside of each section so that you will keep the interest of your tourist.
