The clues are in chronological order, but only involve the first part of the timeline (not the 20th century). When you decipher the clue, make sure you include the date (if available) and a sentence or two of explanation. Some clues ask you to click on a link, but feel free to explore even if the clue doesn't require you to do so.
