**George Packer** is a staff writer for *The New Yorker* and the author, most recently, of *The Assassins' Gate: America in Iraq*, which won several awards and was named by *The New York Times* as one of the ten best books of 2005. His play *Betrayed* won a Lucille Lortel award in 2008.

He has published two other works of non-fiction, *The Village of Waiting* (1988), a memoir about his years in the Peace Corps in West Africa, and *Blood of the Liberals* (2000), a three-generational political history, which won the 2001 Robert F. Kennedy Book Award.

He has also published two novels, *The Half Man* (1991) and *Central Square* (1998), and is the editor of *The Fight is for Democracy: Winning the War of Ideas in America and the World* (2003).

His articles, essays and reviews on foreign affairs, American politics and literature have appeared in *The New York Times Magazine*, *Harper's*, *Dissent*, and other publications.

He lives in Brooklyn.
