Monday, October 27 – **“Spheres of Fears”** (new - premiere)

But when nobody’s looking, he slips a strange frog into the air duct. What happens when this frog grows into a grotesque, alien creature that threatens to destroy Motherboard? And what will happen to the kids when they go inside Motherboard to track it down?

Thursday, October 30 - **“The Halloween Howl”** (encore)

The annual "Halloween Howl" bash in Castleblanca promises to be
