

Submission Release

2. The Material does not infringe upon, violate the privacy of, constitute a libel or slander against, or violate any copyright, trademark, literary, artistic, dramatic, musical, or any other right, of any third party.
3. You acknowledge that there does not now exist, nor has there ever existed, a fiduciary relationship between you and WNET. You make this submission voluntarily. You and WNET have not yet reached an agreement concerning the use of the Material and you realize that no obligation of any kind is assumed by, or may be implied against, WNET unless and until a formal written contract has been entered into between you and WNET, and then the obligation shall be only as expressed in the formal written contract.
4.
